Mostly B's: Everyone in the same color and fabric but different styles.

While it's best you take a traditional route, mixing it up with **different shapes and styles** is a great way to accommodate different body shapes and styles — and give bridesmaids a bit of **personality**.

Mostly Cs: Everyone in the same color but different fabrics.

Stylish with a bit of whimsy, a **mix of fabrics** allows for a bit more fun without looking too modern. This can be done with either bridesmaid dresses from the same designer that offers a variety of fabrics like Jenny Yoo or Amsale, or also with RTW dresses that are all in the same color.

Mostly D's: Everyone in different dresses that coordinate.

Though it's the most challenging way to dress your bridesmaids, when done correctly, it's also the **most fashionable**. Allowing your bridesmaids to wear different ready-to-wear dresses can result in a gorgeous mix-and-match look or a clashing mess, so be sure to give them clear parameters to **keep it looking cohesive**.
